








ULIMA and UQ Double Degree options

Options for students partway through their Program*



^{*}Students must have successfully completed a minimum of five semesters at ULIMA in order to transfer to UQ with credit transfer. At UQ, students must undertake a minimum of 12 courses within their chosen program. Students will then be required to return home to complete their final ULIMA studies in order to successfully transfer any final courses of credit towards the UQ BEL Faculty degree. **While matching of the UQ and ULIMA degrees is done with care, not all courses required by each institution will mean a final one year duration back home. Advice will be provided to you for your personalised study plan.

Entry requirements

- Prerequisites Completion of 2.5 years (5 semesters) in one of the above programs at Universidad de Lima. Please note that this may be flexible and if
 you are studying more or less semesters at ULIMA, please seek advice to see what other study options may be available.
- Entry Scores Overall minimum average of 13/20 on the ULIMA grading scale and selected courses required in order for successful credit transfer.
- Must meet UQ English language requirements. Please view information at future-students.uq.edu.au/applying/english-language-proficiency-requirements
